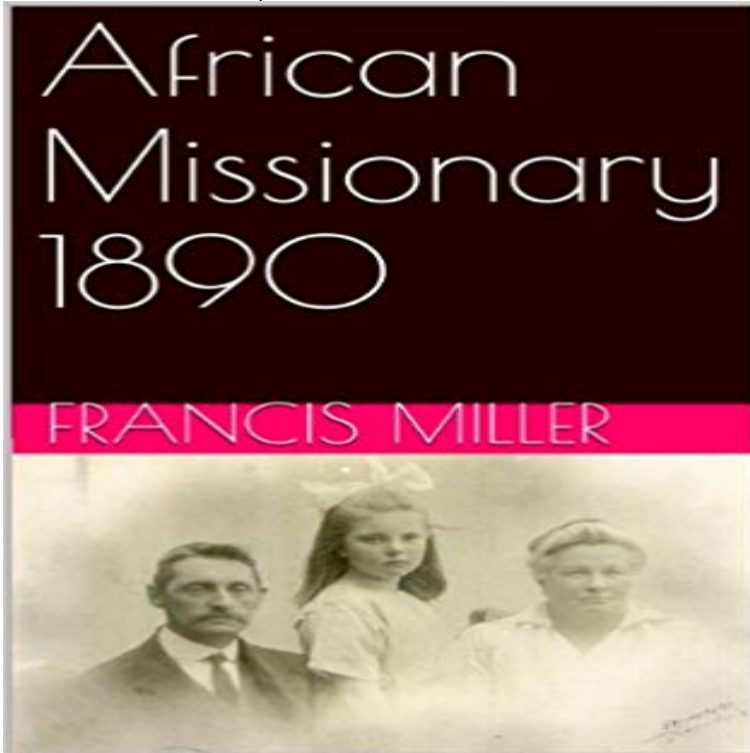


A Missionarys Life in Africa in the 1890s
